Minutes of the Meeting for April 9, 2019

Chair's Welcome: Professor Maley called the meeting to order at 11:17 am.

Approval of CUSA Minutes: A motion was made to approve the March 26, 2019 meeting minutes of the Committee on Undergraduate Studies & Advising. The motion was seconded and passed.

Old Business: Professor Brinton and Professor Brody were in attendance to discuss the CUSA feedback received regarding the KU Core proposal for REL 357.

Dean's Office Update: Associate Dean Storkel shared that Professor John Colombo had been appointed Interim Dean of the College. Associate Dean Storkel also shared that meetings regarding quantitative pathways will continue next week.
