Minutes of the Meeting for December 11, 2018

Chair's Welcome: Professor Maley called the meeting to order at 11:16 am.

Ms. Ledom also shared that the College Advising and Student Services office has been able to see almost double the amount of students this fall compared to last fall due to the increase of Advisor positions.
