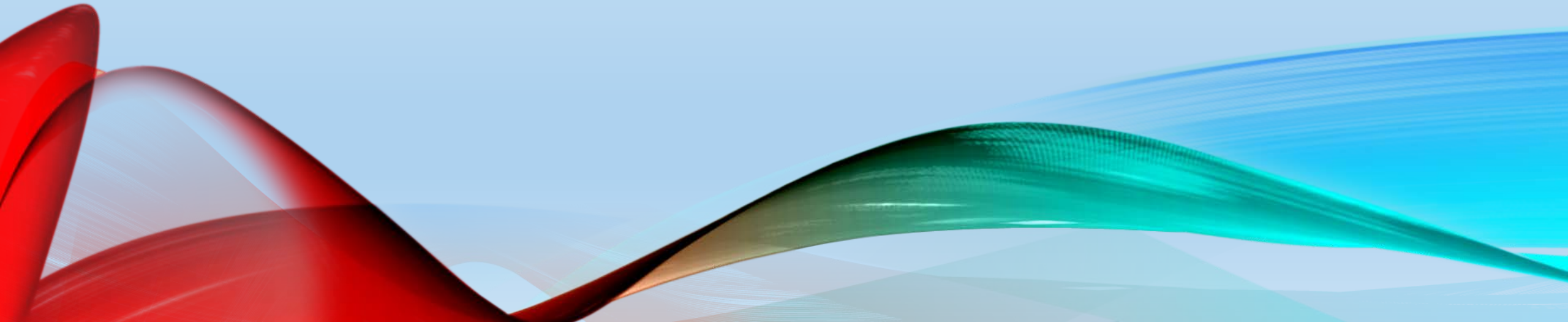

Our Goal

To provide undergraduate students who are currently experiencing academic challenges with an enhanced level of attention and resources so they can progress in their academic goals and graduate.



WHO ARE OUR STUDENTS?

Student Population

❑ **Continue after academic dismissal**

Students who were dismissed for not meeting their probation GPA requirement during spring semester but have been allowed to continue after an academic dismissal. They will have multiple semesters of poor performance but have been approved because they have shown improvement or they are addressing issues that impacted them previously.

❑ **Placed on probation**

These students had a recent term with less than a 2.00 KU cumulative GPA.

❑ **Readmitted after dismissal**

These students had a previous dismissal from KU and have completed the readmission requirements.

Faculty Mentor Responsibilities

- Meet with your student at least twice during fall semester and twice in the spring.
- Submit a faculty mentor feedback form after each time you meet.
- Submit a faculty mentor feedback form if you are attempting to contact your student and they are not responding.

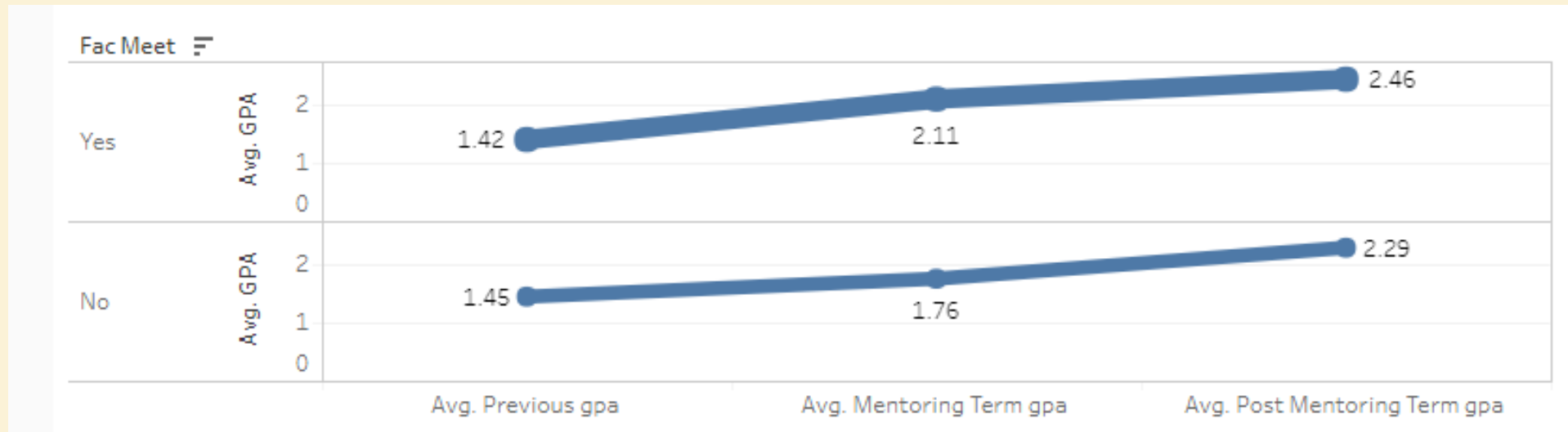
"My mentor let me know if I needed anything at all to always let her know which is small, but very important. She was a valuable part in helping me pass all of my classes this spring 2017 semester!"
